



Design: Floor Plan and Elevations

The finishes A & B represent the light and shadows. A being the shadows and B being the light. Example of the bath being in the shadows and the vanity in the light.








BATHROOM FLOORPLAN


Design: Floor Plan and Elevations



Elevations have been displayed over two slides to enable clarity of the design story.

This slides story is of the shower and the shower divider wall. These extra elevations are necessary as the shower divider wall is not just glass and has body jets positioned on the shower side and towel rings on the exterior of the wall.

Design Visuals: Full Bathroom

The bath is the feature of the room. Set against a shadowy wall of grey as it is a place to relax.

In contrast the vanity is set against the lighter wall as for grooming light is required.





Design Visuals: Shower Area

Shower is fitted with body jets, overhead shower rose and hand shower.

The shower is a combination of light and dark walls. The recessed area is one that light is required but a little shade gives it a little edge.

These are encased within glass and plastered wall.





Design Visuals: Toilet Area

Flush plate is an electronic contactless system requiring hand to hover over the flush button required.

The toilet is placed against a strip of grey. This area is not fully shaded as light enters both through the timber slats.

The wall finishes have been selected to represent light and shadows.





Design Visuals: Basin Area

Vanity is a custom timber laminated design with a profiled cabinet doors. Door are soft touch open / close system.
