The Concept of this design is to reconnect the user to the nature once again, aiming to offer the users a calm vacation trip & a totally relaxing experience. Since this bathroom is designed for shared users, Good hygiene & comfortable cleaning is the target achievement.

The finished product is a calm little oasis of a single story resort that can help the user escape from the hustle & bustle life in the city.

The design of this bathroom offers elegant, sophisticated shades of grey with a touch of modern color range, giving harmony within the space.

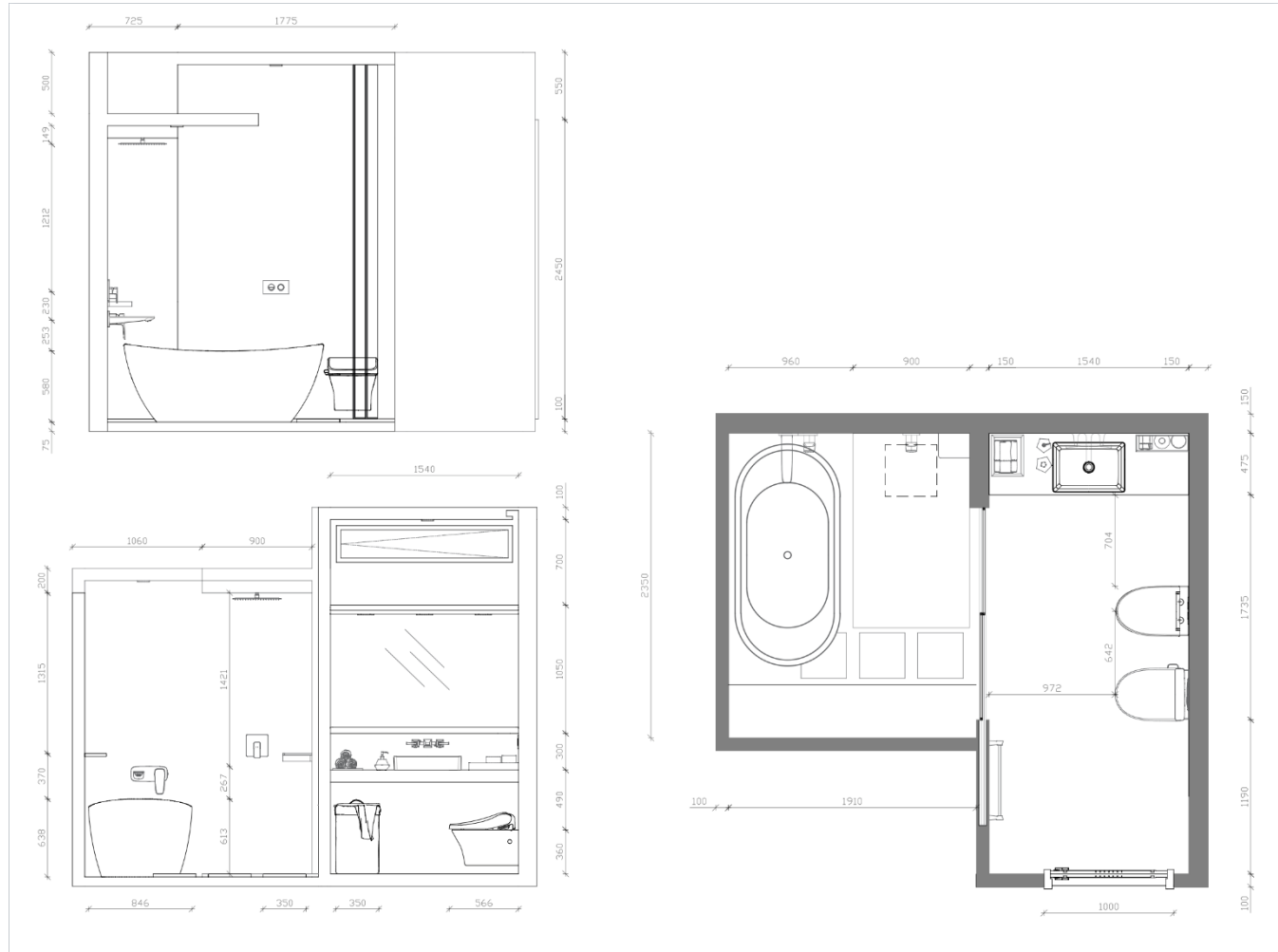
Design: Floor Plan and Elevations

The bathroom measures up to 9.96sqm of total area excluding the wall thickness.

The design is separated into two parts, the outdoor that promotes the connection with nature & the indoor space that is designed to achieve the highest hygiene possible.

The two distinctive space is separated by the sliding glass panel which helps prevent any water from the shower to get into the indoor area. Moreover, with the spalet installed, the user can clean themselves without spilling any water to the floor. thus the indoor area should have good hygiene & is easy to clean or maintain good hygiene

As for the outdoor area is filled with natural settings & open roof enabling the user to feel the connection of the nature such as its calmness, the smell, the sound, the temperature & more. Thus the user can relax while cleaning themselves.



Design Visuals: Full Bathroom

Full view of the bathroom showcasing the distinctive space of indoor & outdoor.

With half of the roof exposed to the air & the use of glass, the indoor should get maximum natural light even if the partition glass is closed to keep the water & odor from each area in tact.

By using grey wall, the smooth porcelain fixture & the timber counter shines brighter to the eyes making it very easy to distinguish each part of the bathroom design.

Since this is for shared user, the cabinet is not necessary, it might only make the space feels more crowded. The space below the vessel is used to promote good hygiene instead. Plus it is easier to clean.



Design Visuals: Shower Area

The shower area is filled with rocks to elevate its natural state, the shower itself rest on a polish concrete slab. There is a small cut of the shower slab that is filled with rock to the lower track of the sliding glass to contact the water.

With the options of rain shower or bathtub to choose, it should elevate the user's relaxing experience.



Design Visuals: Toilet Area

The toilet is positioned to a space with view, the user can choose to enclosed the space or open it to the outdoor. Even if it is close, there is also another open window on top of the mirror instead of a cabinet to allow ventilation incase the indoor space is enclosed.

The spalet plays an important part in this design as it prevents the water from the floor as the user clean up after using the toilet



Design Visuals: Basin Area

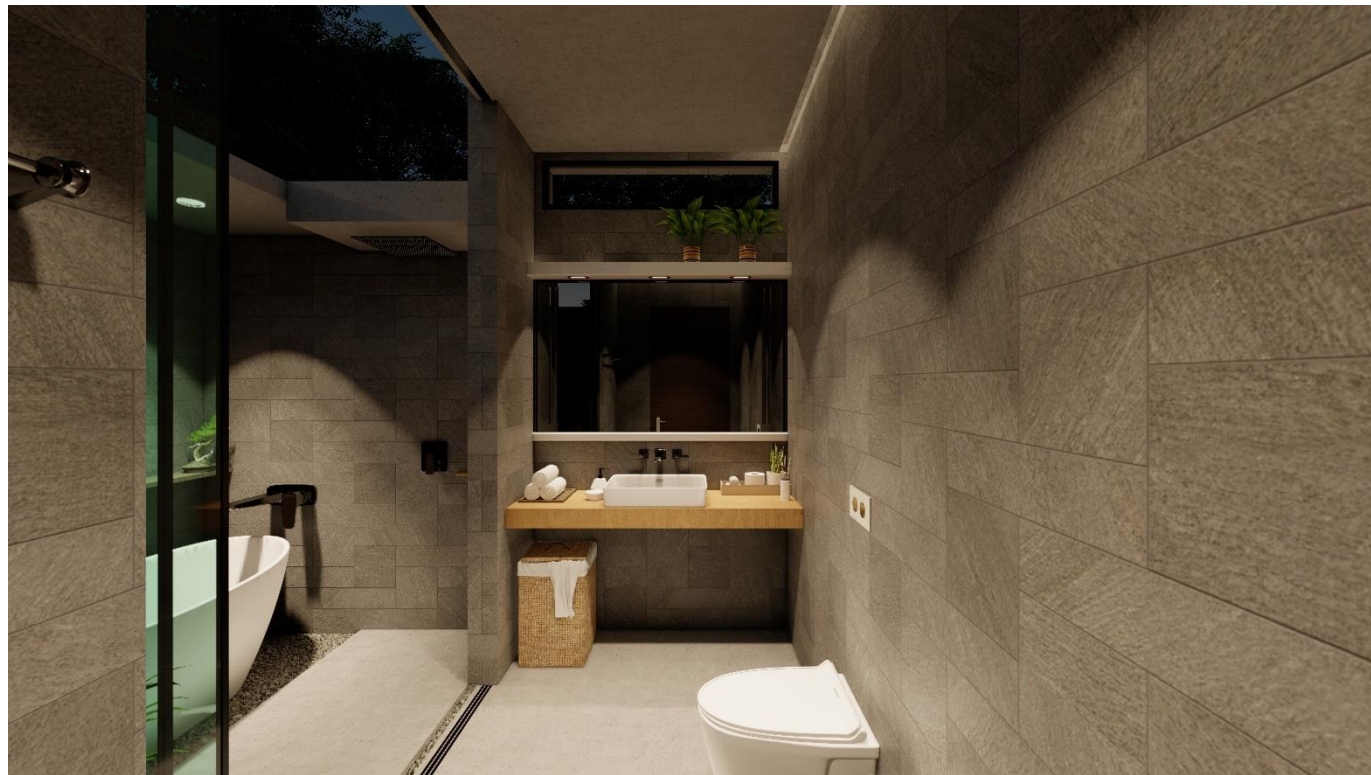
The counter top is a simple piece of timber lying horizontally & in parallel with the mirror. The faucet is concealed into the wall to promote the parallel state of the basin area, this give a clear separation & a sense of detach or flexibility of the entire area.

The area down below can be used as trash bin area or dirty cloth containing area in order to promote good hygiene & ease the cleaning process.
