


Design Concept Summary

A bathroom is defined as a modern space where people undergo their cleanliness ritual, but also a place where, when serving family groups or couples, the space allows them to spend their time together to carry out their ritual. Natural elements, including water flow, rock touch feel, hug tree bark, and warm sun exposure, inspire the designed space. Which is integrated to create an "inside out feel and experience". Therefore, the designed bathroom aimed to improve people's experience, functions, and ambience. The space is divided into zones according to functions and curated experience. For example, the toilet is a dry zone used in terms of materiality to minimise moisture and mould growth. Position of window to allow more natural light into the space. This has additionally enhanced the spatial ambience and reduced the humidity of the zones. Overall, the design is guided towards a high-quality and representative environment where people feel safe, healthy, clean, and cosy.







Design: Floor Plan and Elevations






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






Total Bathroom Floor Area (sqm)





Design Visuals: Overview

Cleanness and hygiene are part of daily rituals, but they are also actions to give people "me time" after a long day/journey. Couple and family group could also enjoy the space together. The space has been appropriately defined and could fulfil each personal comfort and opportunity to share the space(couple/family needs). The bathroom is not only about privacy but, catering to family requirements, fostering time together, and communicating. Additionally, the spatiality provided has little thought by extending functions beyond an essential bathroom.











Design Visuals: Full Bathroom

The space is defined into zones(through curvy and edges) while allowing boundless movement and visibility. It aims to serve "functionality" and "feel safe" while using the space. For instance, when visitors individually accommodate the space, the visibility of the space throughout the planning allows people to calm their minds and emotions and physically feel comfortable using the space.





Design Visuals: Shower Area

The accessibility of natural light has enhanced spatial visibility, reduced energy consumption, and created a more pleasant bathroom atmosphere. We ingeniously adjusted the angle of light towards the toilet zone to minimise moisture and mould growth. At the same time, artificial light is applied to softly embellish certain corners of the space. Spatial design is an experience of feeling safe and cosy, which simultaneously prolongs the desire and time to spend within the space to enjoy the designed space.





Design Visuals: Toilet Area

Regarding materiality, designs take into action both practical and aesthetic needs.

It allowed minimal reflection in the space and was antibacterial, anti-slip, and moisture control. While physically and aesthetically, they have emerged with a feel of nature and connectedness while expressing sustainability awareness.





Design Visuals: Basin Area

Creating a natural feel in a bathroom, especially in the basin area, involves incorporating elements that evoke a sense of tranquillity, simplicity, and a connection back to nature. The basin area design in the bathroom's middle can provide users with a flow circulation.

A versatile basin countertop serves as both a practical dressing table and basin area, offering users convenience and efficiency. During the day, the skylight floods the space with natural light, enhancing the functionality and ambience of the area.


