Design Concept Summary



For a busy household packed with chores and responsibilities from the morning rush to tiring evenings, the bathroom can be easily disregarded despite the weight of its function and power to renew home life. 'THE GRID' is a conceptual design of a modular bathroom inspired by the culture of close family ties among many Asian nations that exhibits warmth as well as the challenge to organize tasks at home. The proposed design envisions uniting family members to an 'island'- a bathroom cube where each can perform daily tasks simultaneously including the use of the toilet, shower, sink, vanity, laundry, and the reminder board to facilitate activities in and out of the home. Rather than concealing the bathroom to one side of the apartment, 'THE GRID' becomes fully functional and exciting- a melting pot of interactions among loved ones without constricting the flow of the household and maintaining healthy close family ties.

Design: Floor Plan and Elevations

'THE GRID' – functional at 360 degrees with the shower on the left, the toilet on the right, opposite is the basin area with the built-in laundry. On the left side of the cube is a vanity set with hanging rods and tall mirror as well as a house plant to brighten the morning. Finally, on the right side of the cube is the reminder board for every family to jot down notes, letters, and paper posts to organize the household activities.

The materials used mimic a warm home resonating common Asian colors and textures. A unique take on bathroom door panels and cabinetry was used through the combination of opaque glass and wood panels to create a Capiz look. Concrete look tiles were used throughout the walls of the cube while pops of colors from the furniture and accessories create a warm family space

A special lighting is used in the enclosed toilet and shower, illuminating the space better without damaging the eyes, as well as making the space bigger with the skylight effect from the design.
