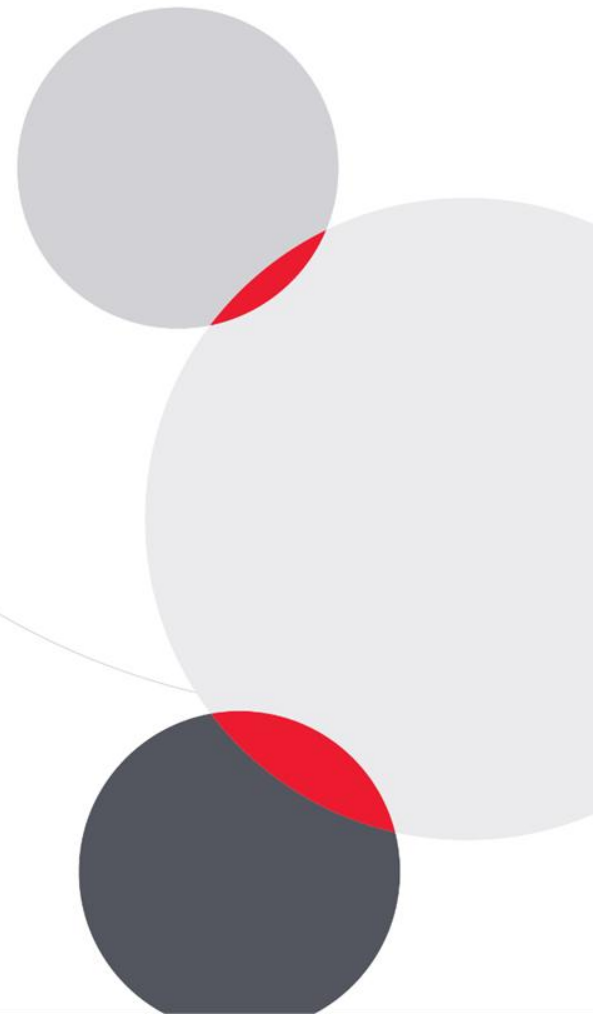

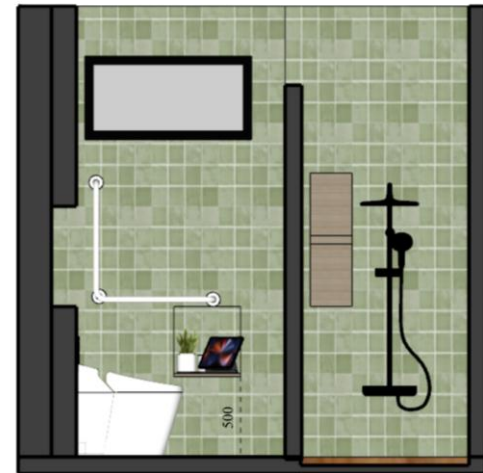
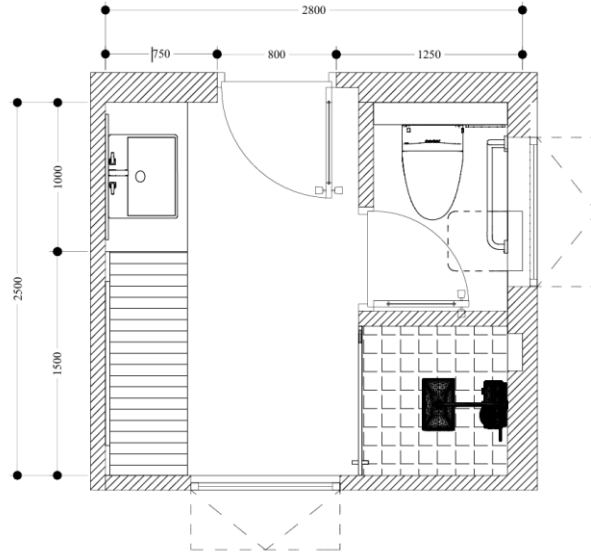
Design: Floor Plan and Elevations

The dry and wet zones are clearly separated. The area beside the sink can also be used as a seating area or waiting area. Windows have been installed to let in natural light and provide good ventilation through two windows.

This area can be used by the whole family because it's divided into zones with doors and seating areas, creating a feeling of shared daily life.

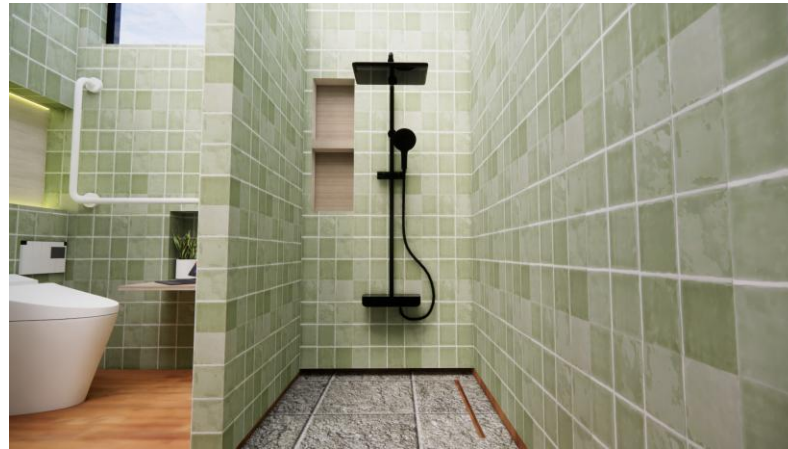

Design Visuals: Shower Area

The wet zone is a shower area with a multi-functional shower head, temperature control, and a shelf for shower accessories. The floor in this zone is sloped at a 1-degree angle towards the drain hole



Design Visuals: Toilet Area

The bathroom will utilize a state-of-the-art automated system. Modernly designed, it will include spaces for mobile phones and iPads, creating a perfect creative space for the social media-driven era. We've also considered the needs of the elderly, so we've installed assistive devices on the sides.

Don't worry about spending too long in the bathroom because it's designed with zones that allow you to shower, wash your hands, or wipe down the toilet at the same time.



Design Visuals: Basin Area

The sink area features a sleek, wall-mounted, floating countertop sink for a sophisticated and uncluttered look. The area beneath the sink primarily serves as storage for items such as towels, and there's also a stool to elevate the sink for children to use while washing their hands. The adjacent zone offers versatile functionality, usable as a play area, shelving, or even an ironing area.



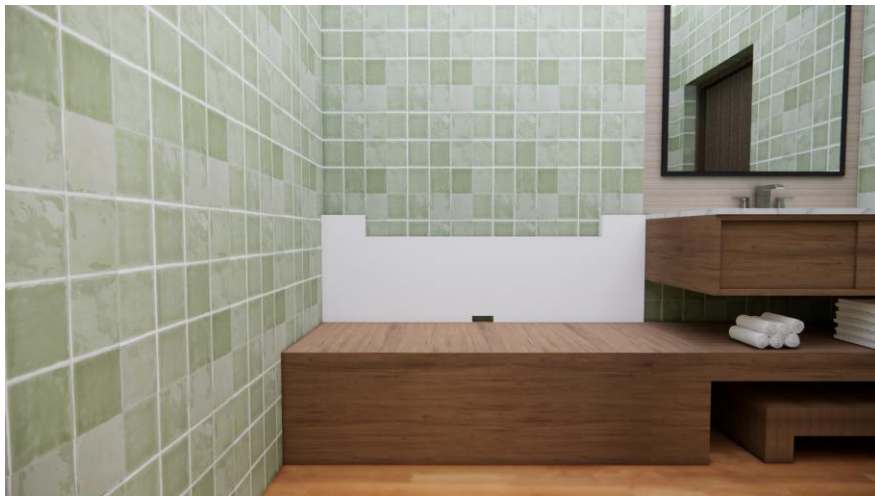

Although the basket isn't made of natural materials, I chose green to represent leaves and nature



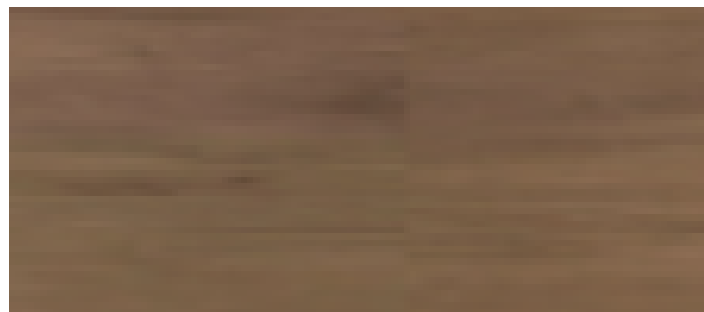
